



# ***2022 Horse Out of The Barn***

**Saturday, May 28**

**Eligibility/Field:** **2-Player Teams**

**Teams may consist of 2 Members or 1 Member and 1 Guest  
Extended Family may play in either Member or Guest spot**

**Entry Fee:** \$100 per Member, \$200 per guest  
\*spouses of participants are welcome to attend the event after play (\$50 fee)

## **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

**9 am:** Practice Facility available

**10 am:** Brunch Buffet

**11:45am:** Tournament announcements @ Practice Facility

**12 pm:** Shotgun Start

**Following Play:** Awards, cocktails, & hors d'oeuvres

**Format:** **One Best (Better) Ball Net**

Players play their own ball on each hole (best net score on each hole counts).

**Handicaps:** 85% of May 1st revision handicaps (maximum of 36) will be used per USGA.

**Prizes:** The Overall low net team, and low men's, ladies', and mixed team(s) will be awarded prizes. There will be Closest To The Hole contests on #7 & #16.

**Tees:** Men play the II tees, unless they notified a golf professional in advance they wanted to play the III or IV tees with a handicap adjustment.  
Ladies play the V tees.

**Ties:** All ties will be broken by the lowest net score on holes 10—18, then 13—18, and so on until a winner is determined.

## **Rules to help with pace of play and fun for all players:**

**“Gimme” Rule:** A putt may be considered a “gimme” if the entire ball is closer to the hole than the distance between the metal bottom of the flagstick and the edge of the black tape. A “gimme” does count as a stroke.

**Penalty Areas:** Marked with red paint. Players may proceed under the rules for a lost or unplayable ball using the last point of entry. If a ball is not found anywhere else on the course, it is considered lost in the general area or out of bounds and players may proceed under the stroke and distance penalty rule for lost ball.
