Seeding: Seeding in all brackets will be completed by sorting indexes from low to high
Byes will be given to the lowest index players if required

Handicaps: August 1st USGA 'Low Handicap Index' (12-month low) used; max. handicap of 36.
In the net division, players will receive 100% of their handicap. The low player will play to scratch and the high player will receive their stroke difference.

Match Ties: All match ties will be broken by a sudden death playoff beginning on hole #1, then #2, etc. until a winner is decided. Net Division: Shots will fall as they did in the match.

Local Rules:

- As per the rules of golf, all areas, unless a bunker, green, teeing ground, or marked as a penalty area, will be considered the 'General Area,' where the 'stroke-and-distance penalty applies for a lost ball (Rule 18).
- The 14 Club Rule is in effect.
- Relief from stance/swing on a **sprinkler head** may be given if the ball is in the general area (not bunker), the head must be on or within two club-lengths of the ball and of the putting green, and must be on the intended line of play.
- For any rules questions that cannot immediately be decided, please seek out a Golf Professional. The '2-Ball/Doubt as To Procedure rule does not apply in match play.
- Designated drop areas are available as an additional penalty area option on #10 and #16.
