



2024 Ladies' Day Scramble

Wednesday, August 14

- Eligibility/Field:** **4-Player Teams**
Teams may consist of any combination of Members and guests
Must be at least one Member or Extended Family on the team
Extended Family may play in either the Member or guest spots
- Entry Fee:** \$50 per Member or Extended Family
\$100 per Guest
- Format:** **Scramble:**
Each player tees off and the best shot is selected. All players hit from that spot, within one club-length (one putter-head length on the green), maintaining the integrity of the lie (i.e. ball in the rough stays in the rough) and repeat this procedure until the ball is holed.
Handicaps: Combined 25% A player, 20% B player, 15% C Player, 10% D Player (rounded to one decimal place). Max. score is triple bogey.
- Contests:** Closest To The Hole: #7 & #16
- Tees:** All players will play the Flower (V) tees
- Handicaps:** August 1st USGA 'Low Handicap Index' (12-month low) used
Maximum handicap of 36

- Ties:** All ties will be broken by the lowest net score on holes 10—18, then 13—18, and so on until a winner is determined.

Rules/reminders to help with pace of play and fun for all players:

- **“Gimme” Rule:** A putt may be considered a “gimme” if it is closer to the hole than the distance between the metal bottom of the flagstick and the inside/bottom edge of the black tape. A “gimme” does count as a stroke.
- The 14 Club Rule is NOT in effect.
- Relief may be taken from **sod seams** only of any newly laid sod.
- **Sprinkler Head Close To Putting Green** (Model Local Rule F-5): For a ball in the General Area, a player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if the sprinkler head is on the line of play (reasonable), within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball.
