Tuesday, August 12—Thursday, August 14

Eligibility/Field: All Male Primary Golf Members

Entry Fee: \$100 per player

Divisions/Flights: Gross Division: 1 Flight (Championship Tees—Approx. 6750 yards)
Format: Individual Gross Matches (18 Holes)

Net Division: Choose From II Tee Flight or III Tee Flight (*with enough players)
Format: Individual Net Matches (18 Holes)
*2 net flights will be created if each have 4 or more players

Schedule of Events:

Men's Gross Division (Match Play)

Tuesday, August 12 8am: Match 1 begins
Wednesday, August 13 8am: Match 2, 12pm Match 3 (if necessary)
Thursday, August 14 8am: Final Match is played over 27 Holes
 Awards presentation following completion of all matches

Men's Net Division (Match Play)

Tuesday, August 12 8:20am: II Tee Flight 1st Matches
 9:00 am: III Tee Flight 1st Matches
Wednesday, August 13 8:20am: II Tee Flight 2nd Matches
 8:40 am: III Tee Flight 2nd Matches
Thursday, August 14 8:20am: II Tee Final Match (played over 18 holes)
 8:30 am: III Tee Flight Final Match (played over 18 holes)
 Awards presentation following completion of all matches

Consolation Bracket: *Players who lose their first match will be entered into a consolation bracket, beginning Wednesday (based on field size). Players will have matches Tuesday and Wednesday.*

Seeding: Seeding in all brackets will be completed by sorting indexes from low to high. Byes will be given to the lowest index players if required.

Handicaps: August 1st USGA 'Low Handicap Index' (12-month low) used; max. handicap of 36. In the net division, players will receive 100% of their handicap. The low player will play to scratch and the high player will receive their stroke difference.

Match Ties: All match ties will be broken by a sudden death playoff beginning on hole #1, then #2, etc. until a winner is decided. Net Division: Shots will fall as they did in the match.

Local Rules & Reminders:

- The 14 Club Rule is in effect.
- Relief may be taken from **sod seams** only of any newly laid sod.
- **Sprinkler Head Close To Putting Green** (Model Local Rule F-5): For a ball in the General Area, a player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if the sprinkler head is on the line of play (reasonable), within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball.
- For any rules questions that cannot immediately be decided, please seek a Golf Professional as soon as possible. Unfortunately, 'playing 2 balls' under Rule 20.1 is not permitted in match play.
